

# Facts about the NorthSTAR 340B Program

What is 340B?

It is a program the government has to allow certain clinics and hospitals to get better pricing on medicine.

How is NorthSTAR able to use the 340B program?

NorthSTAR is forming a partnership with UTMB (University of Texas Medical Branch). UTMB is able to get medicine using the 340B program.

What will 340B mean to me?

1. If you are not in the Medicaid program, NorthSTAR will buy your medicine through the 340B program.
2. The money for medicine will go farther and allow more people to get the medications they need to get better.
3. You will be able to get a physical health screening from UTMB.

Will this program change how I get my medications?

**YES.** This program requires that each clinic have only ONE drug store where you can get your medications.

How will I know what drug store I need to go to?

Your doctor or case worker will tell you what drug store to use to get your medications.

What happens if I go to the wrong drug store?

You will be told which drug store you need to go to for your clinic.
